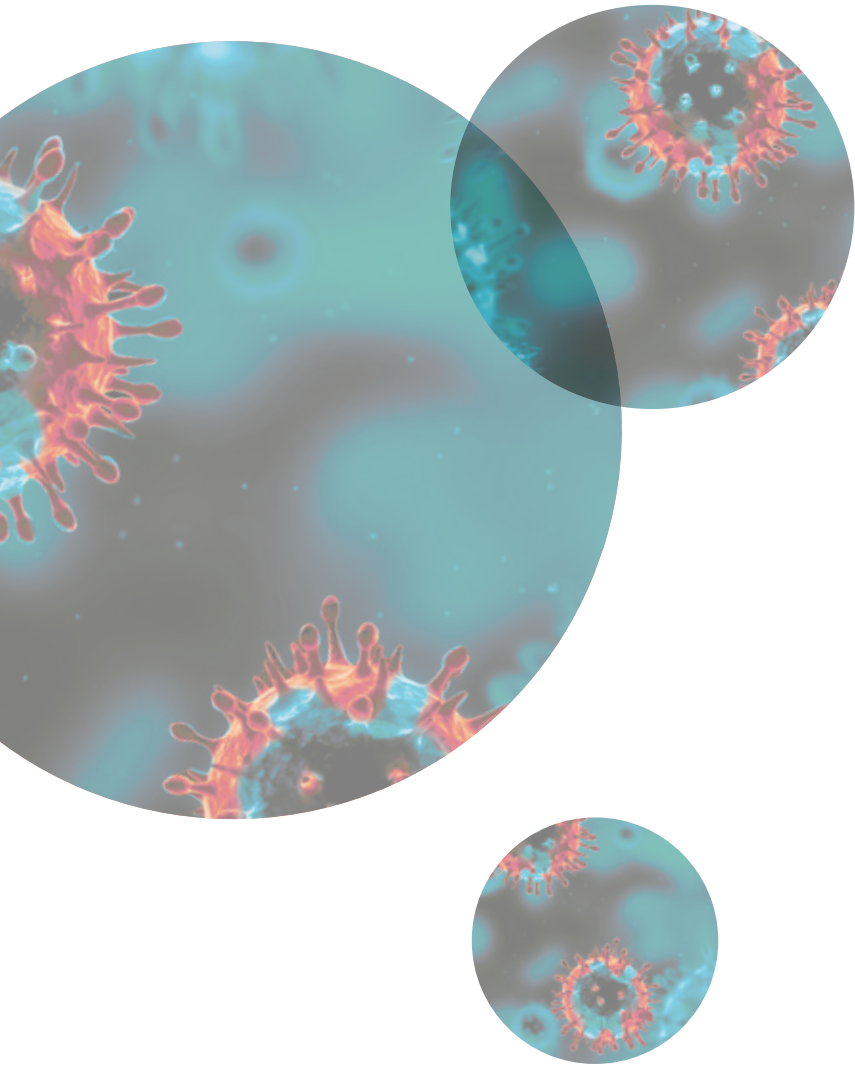
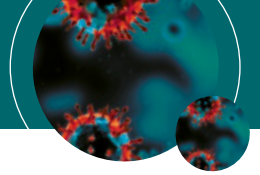

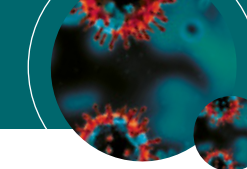

Abstracts can be submitted to the following topics:

- Tropical and Emerging Infections
- Chronic Infections
- Immune Prevention and Therapy
- Antimicrobial Resistance

Once you have registered, you can use your log-in data to make corrections in your abstract until the abstract deadline.

Deadline of submission: 15 September 2021

Submission Type

Abstracts can be submitted as **lectures or posters**.

After the evaluation by the scientific committee, all abstract submitters will be automatically informed about the acceptance or refusal of the abstract. In case of acceptance, you will also receive note about the presentation form (lecture or poster) and time of the presentation.

The presenting authors must register for the Congress.

Registration will not automatically occur upon submission of an abstract!

Form

Abstracts should not exceed 3,000 characters, including bibliographical references and spaces (excluding author names and title).

Charts and graphics can be uploaded in .png or .jpg. formats. No more than two graphics per abstract may be submitted, each of which may not exceed storage space of 2 MB.

- DZIF Prize for Clinical Translational Infection Research

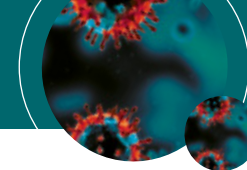
DZIF will award the prizes of EUR 5.000,- each for exceptional translational infection research.

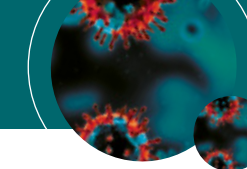
